Signage will be up soon.

Jeanette will order the new vacuum cleaner soon.

Jeanette is working on grant. Ideas discussed were large print books, equity books, furniture to help with social distancing and outdoor seating. She will contact someone to get a better idea.

Joanne read her added questions to the village survey. Jeanette will ask the Department of Libraries for advice on how to word sensitive topics. All agree that there could be a separate page asking if people would like to volunteer and in what capacity. They can put their name on that page and then the survey itself can remain anonymous if people choose for it to be so.
